As many of you know, our son David Kauffman, was incarcerated April 13, 2021, with a sentence of 5 years. He has gone through Lancaster prison, Smithfield (quarantine), Camp Hill (classification) and on Tuesday finally arrived at his destination. Mahanoy Correctional Center is located along interstate 81 N, between Harrisburg and Wilkes Barre.

David is doing as well as can be expected. We are rejoicing that he's growing in the grace and knowledge of his Savior, Jesus Christ. His biggest prayer request has been that his cellmate is a kind person. Each time God has granted that wish. David wants to utilize his time to pursue schooling and wants to study psychology/counseling.

Because he refused the COVID shot, his options have become limited. He may have NO visitors and schooling is done online. He is, however, permitted to have five 45 minute zoom calls each month. He actually prefers that since he can "see" more of his family.

David loves letters! We are looking for 52 committed people (one person for each week of the year) to be part of a chain letter for the next 5 years.

David thanks you dear Weavertown people for all you've done for him. It would encourage him so much for you to stay connected with him. His greatest fear is being abandoned and forgotten.
